



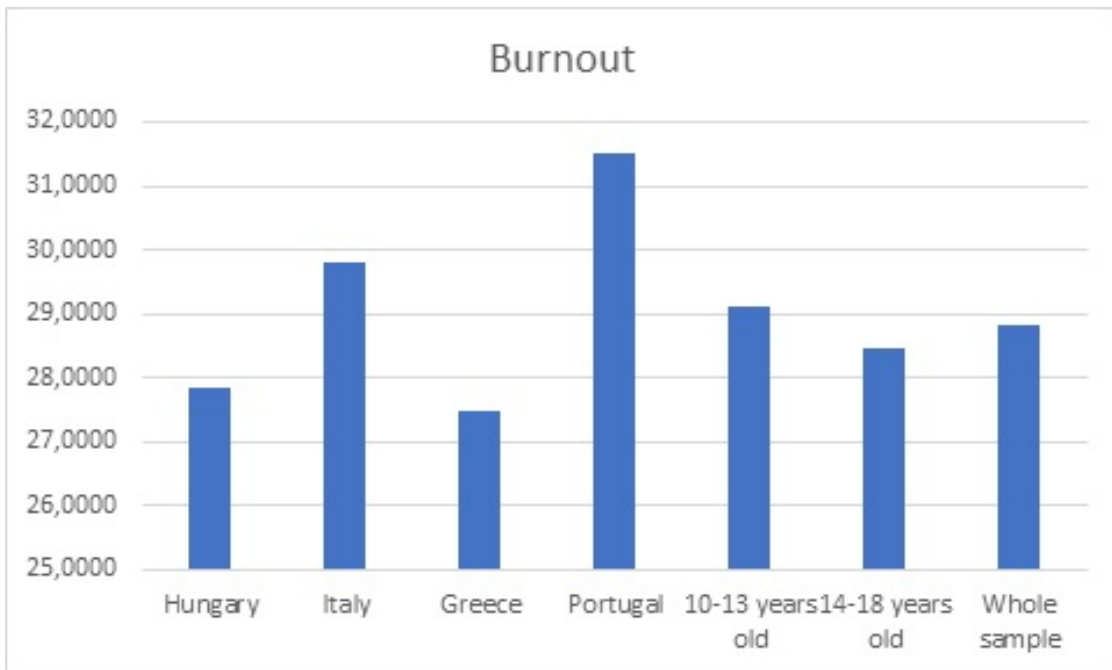
It's time to see a result of the self-assessment questionnaires of teachers!

- **Significant differences in competing, accommodating and compromising conflict management styles among countries**
- Portuguese teachers adapt competing, accommodating and compromising styles much frequently compared to the other countries.
- No one is characterized by a single, rigid style.

And an other result from the self-assessment questionnaires of students...

- No significant age differences and no significant differences between the countries
- Highest burnout scores: Portugal students
- Lowest scores: Greek students
- Half of the Portuguese students sample showed high level of burnout more than a third of Greek and Italian students had a high burnout index.
